This is a reminder that the survey is due February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024. If you are either a behavioral health provider or a primary care provider that is likely to interface with members with behavioral health needs, such as internists, family practitioners, pediatrics, OB-GYNs and any other providers that are likely to interface with BH populations, we are asking that you complete this survey. As you know, integration of physical health and behavioral health treatment for our member's care is a focus for LDH and Healthy Louisiana. According to the National Quality Forum, "lack of care coordination leads to serious complications, including medication errors, preventable hospital readmissions, and unnecessary pain and suffering for the patients. Because physical and behavioral health problems often occur simultaneously, integrating services to treat the whole health of individuals achieves the best results. In order to move toward that goal, we must first assess the current state of integration at the provider level. LDH has chosen the Integrated Practice Assessment Tool (IPAT) to determine the level of integration in the state.
